This garment is inspired by Native American Indians. The problem for the design is to create an ensemble that takes its inspiration and translates it into a wearable couture ensemble. It is a feathered vest and an embroidered skirt. The vest is made of lambskin and is embellished with various kinds of feathers: peacock, ostrich, and pheasant. The skirt is made up of two layers of fabric on the bias. The top gauze layer is embellished with various beading and mohair embroidery in a naturalistic branch-like motif. The gauze that is embroidered was first stretched on straight grain and then embroidered. As the skirt hung on the bias, the skirt developed its gathered effect.
