On Monday, March 3, 2020, the *Journal of Critical Thought and Praxis* received a request to retract an article published in 2017. The manuscript in reference is *(Counter)narratives and complexities: Critical perspectives from a university cluster hire focused on diversity, equity, and inclusion* that was published in Volume 6, Issue 2.

The authors requested to retract because the “Institutional Review Board concluded that [the manuscript in reference] was not correctly processed through human subjects review.”

The *Journal of Critical Thought and Praxis* believes that responsible research should be at the forefront of all work with human subjects. After consideration of this request, the manuscript was immediately retracted and removed from the *JCTP* website.
